The purpose of the Alice & David Crosby Environmental Scholarship is twofold:

- To honor former Clinton residents Alice and David Crosby, longstanding members of the Clinton Land Conservation Trust, Inc., for their lifetime commitment to the environment. David was a distinguished Forest Entomologist and an early and longtime member of the CLCT Board of Directors. He contributed invaluable forestry expertise to the creation of the Trust's first hiking trails in the Peters Woods and Deane Haag properties. Alice consistently supported her husband's environmental activities and concerns and made her own significant contributions to the education not only of Clinton's children, but also to the education of children in Milford, CT, and Juneau, AK, having served for many years as Chairman of the Boards of Education in all three communities.
- To encourage and promote the pursuit of a higher education in the environmental field by providing a \$1,000 scholarship to a qualified graduating high school student who is a resident of Clinton.

Award of the scholarship is at the discretion of the Clinton Land Conservation Trust, Inc., and will be made according to the guidelines set forth within this document. The actual monetary award will be made directly to the college/university on the recipient's behalf.

ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

- 1. Student applicant must be a resident of Clinton and a graduating high school senior.
- 2. Student must be accepted at an accredited institution of higher learning that he/she plans to attend within one year of secondary school graduation.
- 3. Candidate must show evidence of a demonstrated commitment to the environment.
- 4. Applicant's stated academic goals must be focused on the environment (*e.g.*, botany, silviculture, environmental law of journalism, forest resource management, ornithology, etc.).
- 5. Application/addenda shall be received by the CLCT Scholarship Committee in a timely manner.

NOTE: Financial need is not a criterion; however, if you wish the committee to factor financial need into its consideration of your application, please fill out **all** the Adjusted Gross Income sections on the application form.
